



DBRS MORNINGSTAR AFFIRMED SLOVENIA'S RATING 'A (high)', STABLE TREND

On 21 August 2020 DBRS Morningstar affirmed Slovenia's rating 'A (high)', stable trend.

Since the coronavirus outbreak Slovenia's ratings by different rating agencies have been affirmed. Rating agency Moody's (Baa1, outlook positive) affirmed the rating on Slovenia in April, Standard & Poor's (AA-, outlook stable) in June and so did Fitch Ratings in July (A, outlook stable). DBRS Morningstar's assessment proved again that Slovenia maintains its level of creditworthiness.
