



FITCH RATINGS AFFIRMED SLOVENIA RATING 'A', OUTLOOK STABLE

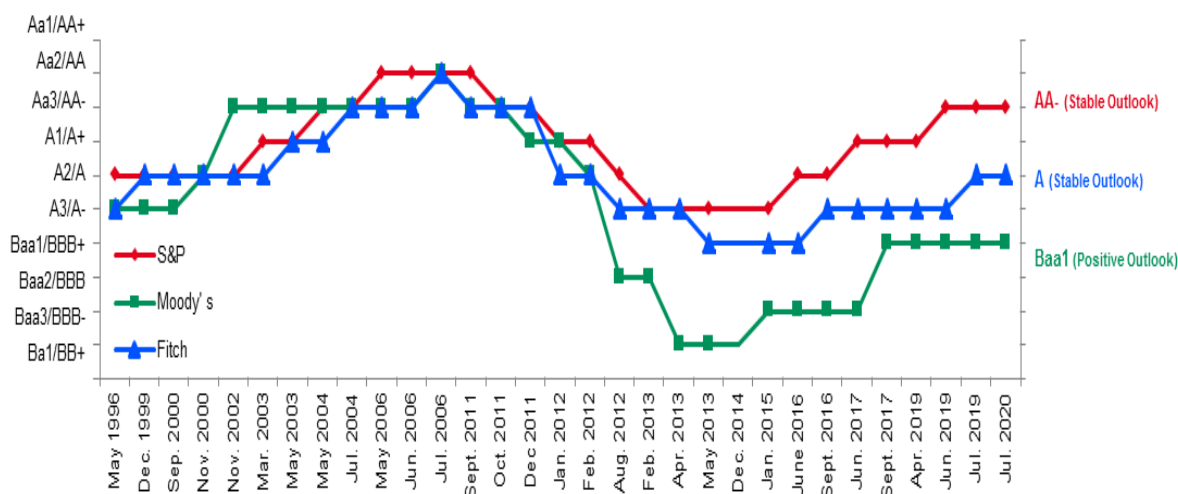
On 17 July 2020 Fitch Ratings affirmed Slovenia's rating 'A', outlook stable.

Although the coronavirus pandemic is exerting considerable pressure on sovereign ratings across all regions, Slovenia maintains its level of creditworthiness. Since the coronavirus outbreak Fitch Ratings affirmation of Slovenia's rating has been the third one in a row; Moody's (Baa1, outlook positive) affirmed the rating on Slovenia in April and so did Standard & Poor's (AA-, outlook stable) in June.
