

PRIME MINISTER OF SLOVENIA DR. MIRO CERAR RESIGNED

Slovenian prime minister dr. Miro Cerar has announced he is stepping down in response to the Supreme Court's decision to annul the September 2017 referendum on the Koper-Divača rail project. Cerar promised he would see to it that the government takes care of the day-to-day business and pressing matters and to preserve peace and stability in Slovenia until a new government is elected.

General elections is expected to take place late in May 2018, which is very close to originally planned regular general elections in the first part of June 2018.
