
Headquarters in **Brussels** and research facilities located in **5 Member States**:

- Spain (Seville)





JRC scientific excellence

- In 2020, JRC published 1117 peerreviewed publications
- 45% of JRC publications belong to the top 10% most cited publications
- 7% belong to the top 1% most cited publications
- Almost 1/4 of publications are among the top 10% most cited, 3% in the top 1%





