MSCA Doctoral Networks

- Support to set up doctoral programmes, with incentives for industrial and joint doctorates
- Support to partnerships of universities, research organisations, businesses and other socio-economic actors from the EU and beyond
- Goal: raise the attractiveness and excellence of doctoral training in Europe and beyond
- Target group: doctoral candidates
 - Support up to 36 months, including secondments
 - Research-related and transferable competences
 - Enhanced career perspectives
 - Innovation-oriented mind-set



MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships

- Support to postdoctoral research and careers
- Incentives to restart research careers, for researchers returning to Europe and for research outside academia
- Target group: postdoctoral researchers
 - New mind-sets, approaches to research and innovation and skills through interdisciplinary, inter-sectoral and international experience
 - Develop skills in and outside academia
 - All research domains
- Two destinations:
 - European Fellowships in Europe (12 to 24 months)
 - ➤ Global Fellowships (12 to 24 months outside Europe + 12 months return in Europe)
 - Secondments worldwide possible



MSCA Staff Exchanges

- Support to high added value collaborative R&I projects to exchange staff in Europe and beyond
- · International, intersectoral, interdisciplinary secondments
- Support to partnerships of universities, research organisations, businesses and other socio-economic actors from Europe and beyond
- Target group: research, technical, administrative and managerial staff
 - Share knowledge and ideas at all stages of the innovation chain
 - Shared culture of research and innovation
 - > Turn ideas into innovative products, services or processes



MSCA COFUND

- Support to new or existing doctoral programmes and postdoctoral fellowship schemes at national, regional or international level
- EU contribution to cover minimum remuneration
- Spread the best practices of the MSCA and excellent working conditions
- Sustainable structuring effects, by promoting excellent and sustainable research training
- Target groups: doctoral candidates and postdoctoral researchers
 - International mobility, interdisciplinary and inter-sectoral experience



MSCA and Citizens

- European Researchers' Night
 - ➤ Organised in +400 cities in Europe
 - > +1.5 million visitors
- Support to organise science outreach events
- Focus on priorities and Horizon Missions
- Target groups: large public, citizens, youngsters
 - Raise young people's interest for research and science
 - Show the impact of research and innovation for daily lives
 - Recognition for researchers' role in society and economy



A greener MSCA in Horizon Europe

- Tangible impact at policy level by setting standards and driving structural change
- Objectives:
 - Strive for a significant reduction in the carbon footprint of MSCA projects
 - Increase awareness on environmental issues
 - Promote sustainable behaviors and policies
 - Support policy and decision making
- Actions:
 - MSCA portfolio analysis
 - Thematic clustering event
 - MSCA Green Charter
 - Guidance material etc.



A more inclusive MSCA

- Special needs allowance
 - Foster accessibility, participation, employability and training of fellows with disabilities
 - Reduced bias in selection and recruitment of fellows
 - > Foster equal opportunities for individuals
- Beneficiaries
 - Simplification
 - Reduced administrative burden
 - Integration in main MSCA grant system
- Individuals
 - Available for all MSCA positions
 - ➤ For Postdoctoral Fellowships, simplification and integration in the application procedure
