

- Bilateral Cooperation






Bilateral scientific cooperation

- ► Intensive development in the field of research and development after Slovenian independence
- Priority countries: Neighbouring countries, Western Balkan Countries, EU, BRIC countries, non-European S&T leading countries (Japan, USA), regionally important countries
- ▶ 37 Agreements on S&T cooperation
- ▶ Joint projects with 17 countries in 2019 on the basis of bilateral agreements and Joint Board meetings
- ▶ ARRS as implementing agency for public calls






Number of bilateral (research) projects 1994-2018

Bilateral S&T cooperation with BRAZIL

- Based on Agreement on S&T cooperation between the Govt. of the RS and Govt. of the Federative Republic of Brazil, signed in 1998 and
- Agreement between the Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Technology of the RS and the National Council for Scientific and Technological Development (CNPq), signed in 2007: 3 public calls were announced from 2010-2014 and
- ▶ 18 research projects were co-finnanced in different research fields: environment, nuclear technology, biology, food, medicine, new materials and forestry;
- Slovenian side (MESS) is willing to renew the research cooperation (waiting to the Brazil response)



Bilateral S&T cooperation with PR of CHINA

- Based on Agreement on S&T cooperation between the Govt. of the RS and Govt. of the PR China, signed in 1993, 12 public calls were announced from 1995 till 2019
- Approximately 200 mobility projects were co-financed in different research fields
- At last 12th S&T cooperation committee meeting (March 2018) it was agreed to co-finance bilateral research projects – call for proposals is running for 3 research priorities – Karst research, Biomedical sciences and Material technologies
- Next call for mobility projects is planned to be announced in December 2019



Bilateral S&T cooperation with USA

- Based on Agreement on S&T cooperation between the Govt. of the RS and Govt. of the USA (the one signed in 1999 has replaced the first one signed in 1993);
- ► For few years the State Department and the Slovenian Ministry were co-financing bilateral projects (till 1998 by the joint fund);
- ► After 1998 unilateral calls for proposals are running. Each year the Slovenian side finances around 100 bilateral (mobility) projects.
