Name of the unit: Making Idrija bobbin lace

Category of heritage:

traditional craftmanship

Brief description:

Bobbin lace making involves the use tools called bobbins that hold the thread. Lace making has been present in the Idrija area since the second half of the 17th century. In the 19th century it spread to a wider area, where it has taken on ever new expressive forms.

Making Idrija bobbin lace has been declared an intangible cultural heritage of national significance.
