Other Site Characteristics

The SPA is almost the same as the Triglav National Park. It includes the main part of the eastern Julian Alps, with the highest Slovenian mountain Triglav (2864 m). The core of the SPA consists of high mountain plateau, peaks and glacier valleys. The area includes Bohinj lake and several smaller high-alpine glacier lakes. Most of the area is covered by forests (63%). The upper part of forests (tree-line between 1550-2400) consists of well preserved complexes of Pinus mugo and Larix decidua (14%). About 23% of the area is rocks and meadows above the tree-line, and additional 10% is covered by alpine meadows and low input agricultural land. Most of the area is touched by some human influence. The park is a popular tourist destination.

4.2 Quality and importance

In the SPA 115 breeding and 85 wintering bird species are known. It is the most important Slovene site for Lagopus mutus (50-75% of the national pop.), Tetrao tetrix (60-75%), Alectoris graeca (50%), Aquila chrysaetos (30%), Ficedula parva (30%) and Aegolius funereus (20%), and the second most important site for Tetrao urogallus (15 %).
