






Transforming Learning Environments: The Saver Saves Scheme

- Green Energy Teams formed in SEUs.
- Support from Energy Manager to assess how the buildings "live".
- Monetary savings remain with the department/building: Revolving Fund.
- Devolves power and decision making.
- Harnesses individual action to drive institutional transformation.
- 21% reduction in absolute energy consumption.


