




Stomach Cancer Incidence

The incidence of stomach cancer across Europe highlights the highest rates in parts of Eastern Europe:

- Highest age-standardised rates observed for Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Slovakia, and Portugal. ¹
- Men had higher age-standardised rates compared to women. ¹
- Several causes for stomach cancer are identified, including Helicobacter pylori. The lowest infection prevalence was observed found in Northern Europe, while the highest were in Eastern and Southern Europe, up to 84% in Portugal and Poland.²




