International bilateral research projects

➤ Strengthening scientific research cooperation with partner countries, establishing new, sustainable international partnerships, **increasing the share of younger researchers** in international research project consortia.

Mobility

- Examples of eligible expenses: accommodation, transportation fees, daily allowance
- Unilateral tender – published only in Slovenia
- Fostering the **collaboration and networking**, involvement of **young researchers**

Scheme of (co)financing according to the lead agency principle (Lead Agency)

➤ Through a Lead Agency Agreement, two or more agencies from different countries/regions allow researchers to apply for a joint research project with one of the agencies (the Lead Agency), which is responsible for carrying out the evaluation process of the joint research project proposal.
