Visual Identity Guidebook Ljubljana, 2024 Development Cooperation and Humanitarian Aid of the Republic of Slovenia





Introduction

This guidebook lays down the basic elements, structures and method for creating documents with visual identity of the brand of the Development Cooperation and Humanitarian Aid of the Republic of Slovenia. The guidebook is designed to assist all employees and external contractors, especially designers and others whose work is related to the production and use of messages and other documents for internal and external users. The aim of the guidebook is to facilitate the management of visual identity and ensure greater recognition and consistency in the project and its communication across all communication channels.

1. Basic visual elements

Sign

The symbol and the inscription form a comprehensive sign that is inviolable. This means that it is not permitted to change the ratios between the elements, distort the sign, use only one of the elements or integrate it in full or any of its part into any other sign.

The sign and the position of the sign depend on the medium or material to which it is applied. The basic variants of the sign are the colour positive, the black and white positive and the negative.

1.2 Construction grid with insulation space

The insulation space is the space around the sign that must not be covered with additional elements, such as text, photo and other graphic or textual elements. It is defined as the square between the symbol and the inscription.

Secondary signs are intended for different definitions of forms of aid that may change.

The secondary versions are also colour positive, black and white positive and negative.

Co-branding - example

For equal co-branding the logos of partner organisations are positioned left of the sign. The partner logo is adapted in size and in positioned in line with the sign.

The insulation space is the space around the sign that must not be covered with additional elements, such as text, photo and other graphic or textual elements. It is defined as the square between the symbol and the inscription.

1.7 Case use - stickers

When using two flags, these are positioned left of the sign. The flag is adapted in size and in positioned in line with the sign.

The insulation space is the space around the sign that must not be covered with additional elements, such as text, photo and other graphic or textual elements. It is defined as the square between the symbol and the inscription.

1.10 Minimum size of the sign

The size of the sign depends on the medium or material to which it is applied, and on the type of print used. The maximum size is not prescribed, but for large applications, please consult in advance the author or custodian of the visual identity. The minimum size is prescribed.

1.11 Typeface

The primary typeface is Republika in two cuts.

Microsoft Arial may be used as the secondary typeface. Its use is reserved for cases in which the use of primary typeface is not possible. This applies mostly to use in programmes, such as Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, Excel and similar.

1.12 Colour System

The primary colour version uses the five colours from the symbol and the inscription. It is used against white background.

The optimum option for printing is spot colour printing as it allows the perfect colour imprint. If spot colour printing is not available, process printing may be used.

In addition to the printing type, the reproduction of colour depends also on the type of paper and the output raster density.

Colours may also be reproduced using the RGB (Red, Green and Blue) model for computer or any other screen display.
