Effective international legal cooperation is one of the fundamental instruments for prosecuting the perpetrators of the most serious international crimes. Following the successful MLA Diplomatic Conference in Ljubljana, Slovenia, in May 2023, The Ljubljana-The Hague MLA Convention establishes a modern operational framework for effective interstate cooperation in the investigation and prosecution of the Crime of Genocide, Crimes against Humanity, War Crimes, and other International Crimes. The Convention will serve as a practical tool that contributes to the international criminal law framework and enables the fulfilment of international legal obligations and the empowerment of national law systems.
