**CIRCULAR NOTE
No. 242/PK/XI/2021**

Referring to the adoption of the latest immigration regulation issued by the Government of Indonesia related to situation of the COVID-19 namely Addendum of Circular Note of National COVID-19 Task Force No. 20 Year 2021 regarding the Health Protocol for International Travel during Pandemic Time, the Embassy / Permanent Mission of the Republic of Indonesia in Vienna would convey the followings:

1. All international travelers, both Indonesian Citizens and Foreign Nationals, must comply with the following rules/regulation:
 - a. Provisions for self-quarantine at hotels for 5 x 24 hours for recipients of the first dose of vaccine and self-quarantine at hotels for 3 x 24 hours for recipients of full-dose vaccines, with all costs being borne by international travelers.
 - b. The Head of Foreign Diplomatic Representatives and their families can self-quarantine at their respective residences for 5 x 24 hours for international travelers who have just received the first dose of vaccine or for 3 x 24 hours for international travelers who have received the full dose of vaccine.
 - c. RT-PCR test shall be carried out 2 times, namely 1 x 24 hours after arrival to the Republic of Indonesia; and on the fourth day of quarantine for the international traveler that performs the quarantine for 5 x 24 hours and on the third day for the international traveler that performs the quarantine for 3 x 24 hours.
2. This circular note enters into force on 2 November 2021 until further notice and will be evaluated according to the necessity.

**CIRCULAR NOTE
No. 226/PK/X/2021**

Referring to the adoption of the latest immigration regulation issued by the Government of Indonesia related to situation of the COVID-19 namely Circular Note of National COVID-19 Task Force No. 20 Year 2021 regarding the Health Protocol for International Travel during Pandemic Time, the Embassy / Permanent Mission of the Republic of Indonesia in Vienna would convey the followings:

1. The international traveler of Indonesian citizen status from abroad is permitted to enter Indonesia by complying to relevant health protocol as determined by the Government;
2. Presenting the card or certificate (physical or digital form) to have received the full dose of COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 (fourteen) days before the departure written in English language, other than the local language;
3. Foreign national who has not received the vaccine abroad will be vaccinated at the quarantine site after a negative result of second PCR test, with the following requirements:
 - a. Age between 12 – 17 years
 - b. Holder of Diplomatic Stay Permit and Official Stay Permit; and/or
 - c. Holder of Temporary Stay Permit Card (KITAS) and Permanent Stay Permit Card (KITAP);
4. Foreign National who is currently in Indonesia and will perform domestic or international travel, is required to be vaccinated through 'Program' or 'Gotong Royong' schemes in accordance to prevailing laws and regulation;
5. The requirement to show the COVID-19 vaccination card or certification (physical or digital form) is excluded for the followings:
 - a. Foreign National holders of Diplomatic Visa and Official/Service Visa related to official/state visit of foreign officials at the Ministerial Level and above as well as Foreign Nationals entering Indonesia under the Travel Corridor Arrangement scheme, taking consideration of reciprocal principle while implementing prevailing health protocol;
 - b. Unvaccinated Foreign National planning a domestic travel as part of an international travel route departing Indonesian territory, are allowed not to present the vaccination card/certificate as long as they do not exit the airport area during the transit for international flight route, with the following requirements:
 - i. Approved by local Health Port Office
 - ii. Present the flight ticket to depart Indonesia with direct transit from departure city to international airport in Indonesian territory with other country as final destination.
 - c. International traveler under 18 years old;

- d. International traveler with special health condition or comorbid disease that caused the traveler not to receive vaccination, are to present medical certificate/letter from Government Hospital at country of origin that stated the traveler has not yet been vaccinated or cannot receive the vaccination of COVID-19.
6. Providing a negative PCR test result which sample is taken maximum 3x24 hours before the departure:
7. International traveler is required to quarantine for a duration of 5x24 hours. The requirements of quarantine place are as follows:
 - a. For Indonesian citizen, namely Indonesian Migrant Worker, student or government official returning from overseas official travel according to the Decree of the Head of COVID-19 National Task Force regarding the Entry Point, Quarantine Place, and Mandatory PCR Test for Indonesian Citizen performing International Travel, is at the expense of the Government of Indonesia;
 - b. For Indonesian citizen other than point 7.a. and the foreign national, including foreign diplomat, except Head of Foreign Mission and the family of Head of Foreign Mission, will be quarantined in appointed quarantine accommodation
8. Head of Mission and family accredited to Indonesia shall perform the mandatory self-quarantine in the private residence for the duration of 5x24 hours;
9. Perform PCR test at the time of arrival. If the test result is positive, the treatment will be carried out at centralized isolation facility for persons without symptoms or light symptoms and at referral hospital for persons with medium and heavy symptom. For Indonesian citizen the cost will be borne by the Government and the payment for foreign national will be borne by him/herself.
10. Perform the second PCR test on the fourth day of quarantine. If the result is negative, for Indonesian and foreign national shall be allowed to continue their travel and are advised to perform 14 days of self-quarantine as well as implement prevailing health protocol;
11. Obligation to quarantine is exempted to holders of Diplomatic Visa and Official/Service Visa related to official/state visit of foreign officials at the Ministerial Level and above as well as Foreign National who enters Indonesia under the Travel Corridor Arrangement scheme, taking consideration of reciprocal principle while implementing prevailing health protocol;
12. Every international traveler is mandatory to use PeduliLindungi application as a requirement for entering Indonesian territory;
13. International traveler with foreign citizen status with the purpose of tourism is allowed to enter Indonesian territory with the following requirements:
 - a. Through entry points of Bali and Riau Islands airport;
 - b. Holder of short visit visa or other entry permits according to prevailing laws and regulations;
 - c. Holder of health insurance proof with the coverage value of minimum USD 100.000 including coverage for payment of COVID-19 treatment;
 - d. Holder of reservation and payment proof of accommodation for the duration of stay in Indonesia
14. This circular note enters into force on 14 October 2021 and shall remain in effect until further notice.
