Introduction

The IAEA and the International Nuclear Security Education Network (INSEN) have developed a set of teaching materials that are based on the IAEA Educational Programme in Nuclear Security (IAEA Nuclear Security Series (NSS) No. 12) guidance and recommendations in the area of nuclear security education. The materials are being used by members of INSEN in their teaching, however, many faculty members, while being experts in their scientific or engineering fields, have limited knowledge in nuclear security and may benefit from initial assistance.

This virtual first session will introduce participants to theoretical subject matter.

Objectives

To assist faculty members from universities in Europe and Asia-Pacific regions interested in establishing degree programmes or courses in nuclear security with focus on physical protection. The course will provide both substantive information as well as methodological and curriculum-development assistance.

Target Audience

Faculty from universities interested in designing and teaching courses and programmes in nuclear security.
